**Resolution urging the Mayor to include funds in his FY 2001-2002 budget to pay for health insurance costs of nonprofit agencies that will increase due to recent action by the Mayor and Board of Supervisors.**

WHEREAS, The Mayor and the Board of Supervisors expressed our commitment to San Francisco's working men and women by approving the "Living Health Ordinance"; and

WHEREAS, This action means increased costs for our nonprofits, who have been suffering without cost of living adjustments (COLAs); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the Mayor to include the appropriate funding to support this initiative in a manner that is revenue neutral for nonprofit organizations; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors respectfully requests the Budget Analyst and Controller to assess the cost of this measure and report back to the Board of Supervisors by June 15, 2001.
