3 **Resolution authorizing local support for street resurfacing projects to be funded by FY**  
4 **2009-10 Proposition 1B State Infrastructure Bond funds from the Local Street and**  
5 **Road, Congestion Relief, and Traffic Safety Account of 2006.**

7 WHEREAS, On November 7, 2006, California voters approved Proposition 1B, the  
8 Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port Security Bond Act of 2006 (Prop 1B);  
9 and,

10 WHEREAS, The Act apportioned \$2 billion for the Local Street and Road, Congestion  
11 Relief, and Traffic Safety Account of 2006 to fund improvements to local transportation  
12 facilities including repair and rehabilitation of local streets and roads; and,

13 WHEREAS, San Francisco's shares of Prop 1B LSR funds were programmed to the  
14 Department of Public Works' street resurfacing program through the FY 2008-17 Citywide  
15 Capital Plan approved by the Board of Supervisors under Resolution 145-07; and,

16 WHEREAS, In FY 2007-08 and FY 2008-09, the State allocated \$1.3 billion in Prop 1B  
17 LSR funds to cities and counties, and between these two fiscal years the San Francisco  
18 received a total of \$33 million to implement street resurfacing projects at various locations;  
19 and,

20 WHEREAS, In FY 2009-10, AB 3X10 the State budget bill, appropriated the remaining  
21 \$700 million of Prop 1B LSR funds to cities and counties and of this amount, San Francisco  
22 will receive approximately \$6.4 million; and,

23 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors appropriated \$2.2 million of FY 2009-10 Prop  
24 1B LSR funds in the FY 2009-10 Annual Appropriation Ordinance No. 184-09, and \$4.2

1 million is proposed to be appropriated to the Department of Public Works in the FY 2011-20  
2 Citywide Capital Plan and the FY 2010-11 Annual Appropriation Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_; and,

3 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works will use \$2.2 million of the \$6.4 million for  
4 projects in the FY 2009-10 street resurfacing work plan and will use the remaining \$4.2 million  
5 for projects in the FY 2010-11 street resurfacing work plan; and,

6 WHEREAS, Each city and county must submit to the State Department of Finance a  
7 list of projects expected to be funded with bond funds before an allocation is made; and,

8 WHEREAS, The adopted project list does not limit the flexibility of the local agency to  
9 make substitutions in response to local priorities; and,

10 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works plans to fund the following list of projects  
11 with Prop 1B LSR funds:

12 Winfield Street from Eugenia Avenue to Cortland Avenue;

13 Plymouth Avenue from Sadowa Street to Ocean Avenue;

14 Howard Street from Steuart to 4<sup>th</sup> Street / 4<sup>th</sup> Street from Bryant to King Street; and

15 Various Locations Bureau of Street and Sewer Repair; and,

16 WHEREAS, The estimated useful life of the proposed repair is between 14 and 21  
17 years; now, therefore be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the list of projects expected to be  
19 funded with 2009-10 Prop 1B LSR bond funds.

**Proposition 1B Local Streets and Road Funds**

Summary

The Department of Public Works (DPW) requests that the Board of Supervisors approve a list of street resurfacing projects proposed to be funded with Proposition 1B Local Streets and Road (Prop 1B LSR) funds appropriated in the FY 2009-10 State budget. Section 8879.65(b) of the Government Code states that local agencies must submit a list of projects expected to be funded with Prop 1B funds pursuant to an adopted city or county budget.

Background

The Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality and Port Security Bond Act of 2006 provided \$19.9 billion in State bond funds for a variety of transportation priorities, including \$2 billion for cities and counties to fund the maintenance and improvement of local transportation facilities such as local streets and roads. The FY 2008-2017 Citywide Capital Plan adopted by the Board of Supervisors May 24, 2007 anticipated that the \$40 million expected to come to San Francisco from Prop 1B would be expended on the street resurfacing program.

Over the first two years of the bond program, the State appropriated \$1.3 billion (65%) of the \$2 billion available to cities and counties. Between FY 2007-08 and FY 2008-09, DPW received a total of \$33 million, which has funded street resurfacing and reconstruction projects shown on the attached report. In FY 2009-10 the State appropriated the remaining \$700 million to cities and counties, of which San Francisco's share is expected to be \$6.4 million.

Because these funds were initially expected to be appropriated over three fiscal years, DPW included \$2.2 million in its FY 2009-10 capital budget. These funds were appropriated by the Board of Supervisors in the Annual Appropriation Ordinance 184-09. The remaining \$4.2 million is included in the FY 2011-20 Citywide Capital Plan (approved April 27, 2010) and in the FY 2010-11 capital budget (Annual Appropriation Ordinance pending approval).

Projects

The table below lists the projects proposed to be funded with the \$6.4 million in Prop 1B LSR funds. Also attached is the proposed program of street resurfacing projects over FY 2009-10 and FY 2010-11. DPW's total street resurfacing budget was \$41.7 million in FY 2009-10 and is \$50.8 million (proposed) for FY 2010-11.

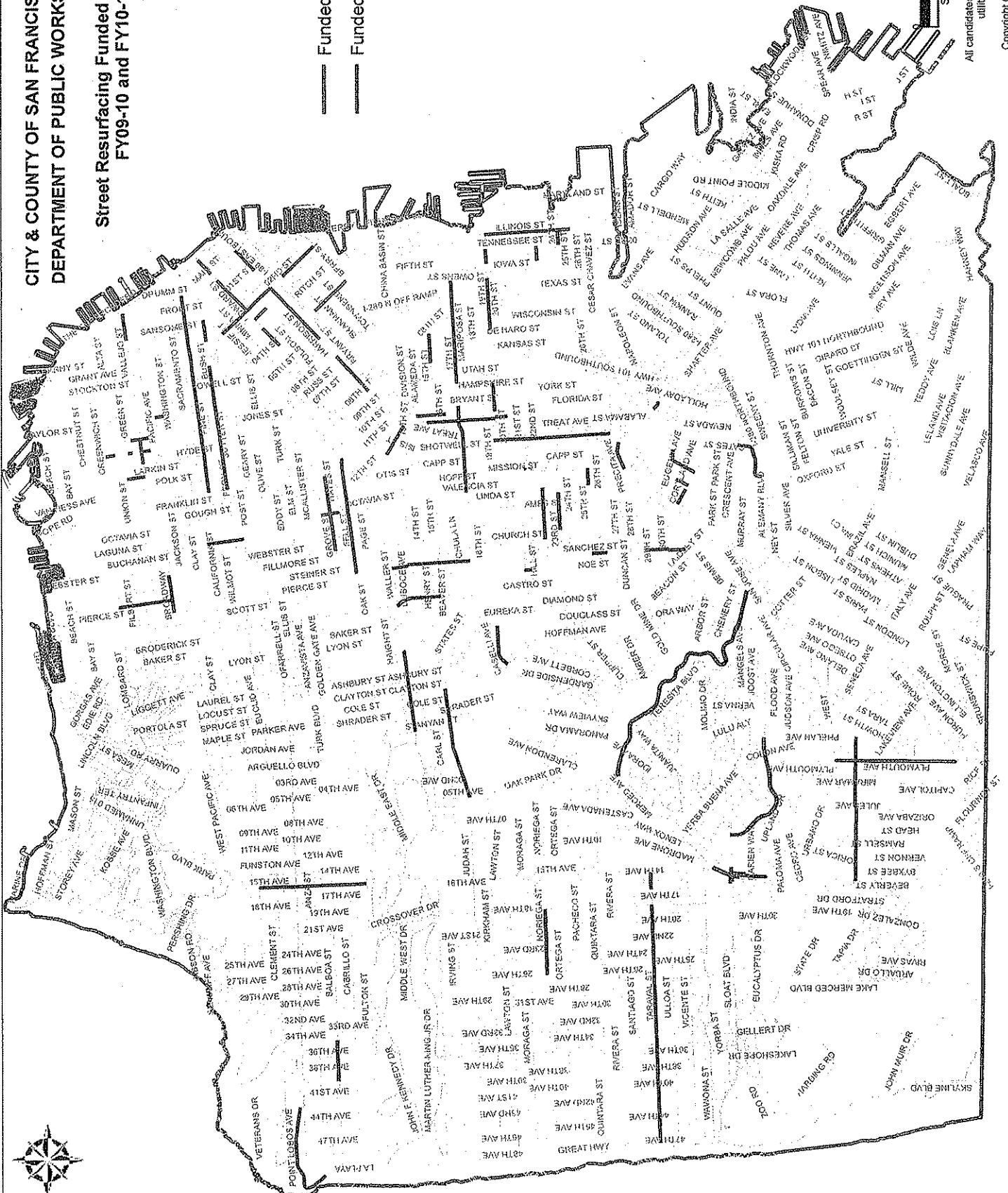

Pursuant to Administrative Code Article XV.Sec.10.170-1.(i), please find attached, a report on the use of funds appropriated from the Local Street and Road Improvement, Congestion Relief, and Traffic Safety Account of 2006 by the Department of Public Works.

According to the subject Administrative Code, any department receiving an appropriation of Proposition 1B Local Street and Road funds shall report back to the Board of Supervisors beginning six months from the date of the appropriation and at six-month intervals thereafter with the following information:

- the amount of Proposition 1B Local Street and Road (LSR) Improvement Funds expended as of the reporting date
- progress on projects
- projected date of completion

To date, a total of \$33 million has been allocated and received by San Francisco DPW. Of this amount, DPW has expended or encumbered \$19.3 million.
