

1 **[State Grant - Domestic Violence Prosecution]**

2 AUTHORIZING RETROACTIVELY THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND  
3 COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND FUNDS IN THE  
4 AMOUNT OF \$108,000 THROUGH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR  
5 A PROJECT ENTITLED "SPOUSAL ABUSER PROSECUTION PROGRAM" FOR THE  
6 TWELVE MONTH PERIOD JULY 1, 1998 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1999, AND WAIVING  
7 INDIRECT COSTS DUE TO FUNDING CONSTRAINTS.

9 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to continue a project entitled  
10 the "Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program (SAPP)", to be funded, in part, from funds made  
11 available through Chapter 599, 1994 Statutes, administered by the California Department of  
12 Justice; and

14 WHEREAS, The project enhances the capacity of the District Attorney's Office to  
15 prosecute domestic violence offenses; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant local  
17 funds that would, in the absence of the Spousal Abuser Prosecution program, be made available  
18 to support the prosecution of individuals accused of domestic violence; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco, through the Office  
21 of the District Attorney, shall provide no less than the twenty percent required match for the  
22 project; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute and amend  
24 any necessary grant documents for this project; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grantee and the implementing agency. The State of California and Department of Justice disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and, be it


FURTHER RESOLVED, That indirect costs are waived due to funding constraints; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco is retroactively authorized to apply for, accept, and expend funds in the amount of \$108,000 made available through the California Department of Justice for a project entitled, "Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program" for the twelve month period July 1, 1998 through June 30, 1999.

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


