

1 [Sewer Emergency]

2 APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY WORK TO REPLACE  
3 THE STRUCTURALLY INADEQUATE SEWERS IN CLAY STREET FROM STOCKTON TO  
4 POWELL STREETS AND JOICE STREET FROM SACRAMENTO TO CLAY STREETS.

5 WHEREAS, On July 17, 1998, PUC Sewer Operations identified an emergency condition on  
6 Clay Street from Stockton to Powell Streets and Joice Street from Sacramento to Clay Streets; and

7 WHEREAS, The existing sewer had collapsed, and immediate replacement was required in  
8 order to protect the health, welfare, and property of the Citizens of San Francisco; and

9 WHEREAS, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for Contract  
10 No. CW-199E, "Clay/Joice Streets Emergency Sewer Replacement" to replace the existing sewers  
11 with 504 linear feet of 18" diameter and 256 linear feet of 12" diameter VCP sewers in Clay Street  
12 from Stockton to Powell Streets and Joice Street from Sacramento to Clay Streets; and

13 WHEREAS, the Contractor, Troy's / Trinet Joint Venture began the emergency work on  
14 August 3, 1998 and completed it on September 1, 1998; and

15 WHEREAS, Because this was an emergency contract, HRC subcontracting goals were not  
16 established by the HRC Contract Compliance Officer assigned to monitor the Clean Water Repair and  
17 Replacement Program; and

18 WHEREAS, The cost of the project is estimated to be \$255,415.00, of which \$207,765.00 is  
19 for the construction contract. Funds are available from the R&R Fund (Fund 5C/CPF/R&R, FAMIS  
20 Project No. CENRNR988, Job Order No. 1618N); now, therefore, be it

21 WHEREAS, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section  
22 6.30 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an  
23 emergency; now, therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approve the expenditure of funds for the  
25 emergency work to replace the structurally inadequate sewer in Clay Street from Stockton to Powell

1 Streets and Joice Street from Sacramento to Clay Streets.




