

1 [Reversing adoption of the negative declaration for 787 (aka 785) Brannan Street]

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3 **Motion reversing the Planning Commission adoption of the final negative declaration**  
4 **for 787 (aka 785) Brannan Street.**

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6 WHEREAS, On November 13, 2004, the Environmental Review Officer of the Planning  
7 Department issued a preliminary mitigated negative declaration for 787 (aka 785) Brannan  
8 Street in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”), the CEQA  
9 Guidelines and San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 31; and

10 WHEREAS, On February 3, 2005, following a noticed public hearing, the Planning  
11 Commission by motion adopted a Final Mitigated Negative Declaration for 787 (aka 785)  
12 Brannan Street (“negative declaration”) in accordance with Administrative Code Section  
13 31.11(h). A copy of said document is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File  
14 No. 050365 and is incorporated by reference herein; and

15 WHEREAS, On February 23, 2005, the Clerk of the Board received an appeal of the  
16 negative declaration from Gerrie Scott on behalf of Citizens for a Cleaner, Safer SOMA  
17 (“Appellant”); and

18 WHEREAS, This Board of Supervisor’s held a duly noticed public hearing on March 29,  
19 2005, to consider the negative declaration appeal filed by Appellant; and

20 WHEREAS, This Board has reviewed and considered the negative declaration and  
21 heard testimony, the appeal letter, a responses to concerns document prepared by the  
22 Planning Department and received public comment regarding the adequacy of this document;  
23 and

24 WHEREAS, The negative declaration files and all correspondence and other  
25 documents have been made available for review by this Board and the public. These files are

1 available for public review by appointment at the Planning Department offices at 1660 Mission  
2 Street, and are part of the record before this Board by reference herein; now, therefore, be it  
3           MOVED, That this Board of Supervisors reverses the Planning Commission's adoption  
4 of the negative declaration.

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
