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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Newcomers**  
5 **Health Program (SFDPH, Newcomers) to accept and expend retroactively a new**  
6 **continuing grant in the initial amount of \$45,000, from the State Department of Health**  
7 **Services, Refugee Health (DHS, RH) to improve treatment of Latent Tuberculosis**  
8 **Infection (LTBI) in refugees newly arriving in San Francisco; for the period of August 1,**  
9 **2003, to June 30, 2004.**

10 WHEREAS, SFDPH, Newcomers has been awarded a new continuing grant from DHS,  
11 RH in the initial amount of \$45,000, to improve treatment of Latent Tuberculosis Infection  
12 (LTBI) in refugees newly arriving in San Francisco; and,

13 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit public agencies to include indirect costs in their  
14 grant budgets; and,

15 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors  
16 because we did not receive the grant award notice until July, 2003; and,

17 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds  
18 may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually  
19 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure  
20 of grant funding; now, therefore, be it


21 RESOLVED, That SFDPH, Newcomers, is hereby authorized to accept and expend


1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded

3 agreement expires.  
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


