SUBJECT: LEGISLATION INTRODUCED

1 [Amending Ordinance No. 1061 - Sidewalk Width Change - Portions of Silver and Revere
2 Avenues]

3 **Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled “Regulating the Width of Sidewalks”**
4 **to change the official sidewalk width at the westerly corner of the intersection of Silver**
5 **and Revere Avenues and portions of Revere Avenue; affirming the Planning**
6 **Department’s determination under the California Environmental Quality Act; and**
7 **making findings of consistency with the General Plan, and the eight priority policies of**
8 **Planning Code, Section 101.1.**

16 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

17 Section 1. Findings.

18 (a) The Planning Department, in its letter dated June 23, 2014, determined that the
19 actions contemplated in this ordinance are consistent with the General Plan and in
20 conformance with the eight priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of said
21 letter is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. ___ and is incorporated
22 herein by reference. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own the findings in said letter.

23 (b) In the abovementioned letter, the Planning Department determined that the actions
24 contemplated in this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act
25 (California Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.). The Board of Supervisors affirms
this determination.

1 (c) The Public Works Director issued Public Works Order No. 183688, dated June 5,
2 2015, including sidewalk width change drawing Q-20-758, regarding the actions in this
3 ordinance. The proposed sidewalk width change will accommodate safe drop-off zone for
4 students that will be attending the new Willie L. Brown Jr. Middle School. A copy of said
5 Order is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. ____ and is incorporated
6 herein by reference.

7
8 Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works' Order No. 183688,
9 dated June 5, 2015, Board of Supervisors Ordinance No.1061, entitled "Regulating the Width
10 of Sidewalks," a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General
11 Ordinances, in effect May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to
12 read as follows:

13 Section 1602. Changing the official sidewalk width of: a) the westerly corner of the
14 intersection of Silver and Revere Avenues, b) Revere Avenue starting 268.38 feet northwest
15 of the westerly corner of the intersection of Silver and Revere Avenues, as shown on Public
16 Works drawing Q-20-758, of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File
17 No._____.

18
19 Section 3. The San Francisco Unified School District, as is necessary as a result of
20 this ordinance, shall make arrangements with public utility companies and City Departments
21 for the relocation, and/or modification of any affected public facilities. Any necessary
22 relocation, modification, or both of such facilities shall be at no cost to the City.

23
24 Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
25 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the


1 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
2 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
