2 AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC AND DIRECTOR
3 OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND UP TO \$840,389 IN TRANSPORTATION
4 EQUITY ACT FOR THE 21ST CENTURY FUNDS FOR VARIOUS TRANSPORTATION
5 ENHANCEMENT PROJECTS WITH REQUIRED LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS OF \$109,004.

7 WHEREAS, The United States Congress enacted the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st
8 Century (TEA21) in June 1998, which made available approximately \$14.4 billion in federal funds to
9 the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) ; and,

10 WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) will be reviewing project
11 proposals from the nine-county Bay Area region for compliance with federal and state rules and
12 regulations as promulgated by the Federal Highway Administration and Caltrans; and,

13 WHEREAS, MTC has advised that San Francisco's share of federal TEA21 funds for
14 transportation enhancement projects totals \$2,700,000 and is available for eligible projects and
15 programs through the end of federal FY 2002-03; and,

16 WHEREAS, Department of Parking and Traffic is requesting a TEA21 grant totaling \$296,389
17 to implement a "Share the Road" Bicycle Safety Campaign, and,

18 WHEREAS, The Department of Public is requesting a TEA21 grant totaling \$544,000 to
19 implement neighborhood traffic-calming and beautification improvements near Cashmere and LaSalle,
20 25th, Dakota, and Texas, and La Playa and Great Highway; and,

21 WHEREAS, Under federal grant regulations, a local match totaling \$109,004 is required and
22 indirect project costs are ineligible, and,

23 WHEREAS, The non-federal share of \$109,004 will be paid for with monies from departmental
24 funds; now therefore be it


