Overview

- Since 2005, San Francisco has helped over 11,000 households experiencing, or at risk of homelessness reunite with support networks and stable homes outside the city.
- There are currently **two City programs** that offer relocation assistance, which under the proposed Ordinance will become **permanent programs** under the umbrella of "**Homeward Bound**".
- The City also administers a low-barrier, temporary emergency response
 program that offers relocation assistance services as part of the Drug Market
 Agency Coordination Center (DMACC). This program is jointly administered by
 HSA and HSH.


