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Resolution approving a maintenance agreement with the State of California, Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for the newly constructed Cesar Chavez Bike Bridge and at-grade pedestrian/bike path on State Route 101 at Cesar Chavez Street and authorizing official acts in furtherance thereof.

WHEREAS, On April 16, 2001, the Board of Supervisors, in Resolution 302-01, approved a Cooperative Agreement with the State of California, Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to construct the Cesar Chavez Bike Bridge on State Route 101 at Cesar Chavez Street that is an overcrossing to provide a connection for bicyclists traveling westbound along Cesar Chavez Street between Vermont Street and Potrero Avenue and to widen an existing asphalt concrete path along the south side of Cesar Chavez Street to provide equal access for bicyclists and pedestrians. A copy of said Resolution and accompanying documents are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 010532, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, The construction of the Cesar Chavez Bike Bridge and at-grade pedestrian/bike path was completed on April 2004; and,

WHEREAS, As part of the Cooperative Agreement, the City and Caltrans agreed upon the control and maintenance responsibilities of the various portions of the improvements; and,

WHEREAS, The abovementioned maintenance responsibilities are set forth in the maintenance agreement between the City and Caltrans. A copy of the maintenance agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 050099 and is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, In DPW Order No. 175,196, dated 2005, the Director of Public Works recommended that the Board approve the maintenance agreement. A copy of said Order is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 050099, and is incorporated herein by reference now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the maintenance agreement with Caltrans apportioning maintenance responsibilities for the newly constructed Cesar Chavez Bike Bridge and at-grade pedestrian/bike path on State Route 101 at Cesar Chavez Street in substantially the same form as the agreement attached hereto; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes and directs the Clerk of the Board and the Director of Public Works to take any and all actions which they or the City Attorney may deem necessary or advisable in order to effectuate the purpose and intent of this Resolution (including, without limitation, signing the aforementioned maintenance agreement and filing such document in the official records of the Department of Public Works).
