City and County of San Francisco, et al (Real Party in Interest: 13 Alane Bernadette Baca). 14 15 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco: 16 Section 1. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to settle the action entitled Department of Fair Employment and Housing, et al., v. City and County of San Francisco, et 17 18 al., San Francisco Superior Court, Court No. 325-126, by (1) paying \$100,000.00 to Alane Bernadette Baca and her attorneys, the law firm of Minami, Lew & Tamaki, for all damages, 19 20 attorneys' fees and costs, (2) crediting Alane Bernadette Baca's sick leave balance with the 21 City with six (6) weeks of sick leave, and (3) issuing a Police Department "A" priority 22 Department Bulletin updating Police Department General Order 11.07, incorporating that 23 Bulletin into specified Police Department EEO trainings, and initiating the process of 24 reviewing, and where applicable, revising Police Department General Order 11.07.
