12	specialty care access; and		
13	WHEREAS, The efficiencies that will be gained with standardization will sustainably		
14	improve the scheduling process (fewer errors in scheduling, better patient experience, fewer		
15	empty clinic slots due to last-minute registration), help to free up clinic staff to help provide		
16	greater access to patients via telephone, and to referring providers via Electronic Health		
17	Records (EHR) communication; and		
18	WHEREAS, These efforts align with Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital and		
19	Trauma Center's True North goals of Quality, Care Experience and Workforce Development;

22	WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received		
23	the agreement on February 22, 2024, for a project start date of February 28, 2024; and

25	program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it
