2 Johnson - \$30,000]

3 **Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by A. J., a minor, by and through**  
4 **her guardian ad litem, Chantel Johnson, against the City and County of San Francisco**  
5 **for \$30,000; the lawsuit was filed on September 6, 2011, in San Francisco Superior**  
6 **Court, Case No. CGC-11-513954; entitled A. J., by and through her guardian ad litem,**  
7 **Jennifer Rodriguez v. City and County of San Francisco, et al.; removed to federal court**  
8 **on December 12, 2013, and re-captioned as A. J. a minor, by and through her guardian**  
9 **ad litem, Chantel Johnson v. City and County of San Francisco, et al.; United States**  
10 **District Court, Case No. 13-cv-5770 EMC.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby  
14 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled A. J. a minor, by and through her  
15 guardian ad litem, Chantel Johnson, United States District Court, Case No. 13-cv-5770 EMC  
16 by the payment of \$30,000.

17 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in the Superior Court of the City and  
18 County of San Francisco on September 6, 2011, initially entitled A. J., by and through her  
19 guardian ad litem, Jennifer Rodriguez v. City and County of San Francisco, et al., Case No.  
20 CGC-11-513954 and removed to the United States District Court on December 12, 2013, and  
21 re-captioned as A. J. a minor, by and through her guardian ad litem, Chantel Johnson v. City  
22 and County of San Francisco, et al.; and the following parties were named in the lawsuit:




