EO#	TITLE	WHAT IT DOES
13767	Border Security and Immigration Enforcement Improvements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Builds southern border wall</li><li>▪ Increases immigration enforcement</li><li>▪ 10,000 more border agents</li></ul>
13768	Enhancing Public Safety in the Interior of the United States	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Defunds sanctuary cities</li><li>▪ Reinstates S-COMM</li><li>▪ Expands immigration enforcement resources</li></ul>
13769	Protecting the Nation from Terrorist Entry into the United States by Foreign Nationals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Bans visa holders from seven majority Muslim countries from entering the U.S. for 90 days</li><li>▪ Suspends refugee resettlement program for 120 days</li><li>▪ Indefinitely bans Syrian refugees from entering U.S.</li></ul>

<b>U N S I G N E D</b>	<b>Ending Unconstitutional, Executive Amnesties</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ No new or renewal DACA applications</li><li>▪ Current DACA work permits continue until expiration</li><li>▪ Rescinds DAPA program entirely (blocked from implementation)</li></ul>
	<b>Protecting Taxpayer Resources by Ensuring Our Immigration Laws Promote Accountability and Responsibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Prohibits entry of any immigrant likely to be eligible for any kind of public benefit</li><li>▪ Allows for deportation of visa holders who receive public benefits</li><li>▪ Requires Sponsors to reimburse the federal government for any benefits used</li></ul>
