1	[Prohibition on Cruise Ship Pollution in San Francisco Bay]
2	
3	Resolution supporting Assembly Bills 2093 and 2672 to prohibit cruise ship pollution California.
4	
5	WHEREAS, The cruise industry is predicted to grow in California by at least 25 percent
6	in the next 10 years; and
7	WHEREAS, Every week a typical cruise ship can lawfully dump 210,000 gallons of
8	sewage and one million gallons of graywater into the ocean; and
9	WHEREAS, Cruise ship discharges have the potential to harm the environment by
11	degrading water quality and threatening the health of marine life; and
12	WHEREAS, Cruise ships do not need to dump sewage or graywater into the coastal
13	waters of California or San Francisco Bay as part of their normal operations; and
14	WHEREAS, Most cruise lines follow a voluntary no-discharge policy into California
15	waters; and
16	WHEREAS, These Assembly bills would put voluntary policy into statute with
17	provisions for reporting, enforcement and penalties; and
18	WHEREAS, AB2093 would prohibit the discharge of all graywater from cruise ships
19	
20	into state waters including San Francisco Bay; and
21	WHEREAS, AB26782 would prohibit the discharge of all sewage from cruise ships into
22	state waters including San Francisco Bay; and

1	WHEREAS, In 2003 the Board of Supervisors supported cruise ship pollution bills
2	AB121 and AB906 that were signed into law that prohibit the dumping of sewage sludge, oily
3	waste and hazardous waste into state waters; and
4	WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco has adopted the precautionary principle as an
5	overriding guide for protecting the environmental health of the city and San Francisco Bay;
6	now, therefore, be it
7	RESOLVED, The City and County of San Francisco supports AB2093 (Nakano) and
8 9	AB2672 (Simitian); and be it
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk to
11	forward a copy of this resolution to San Francisco's representatives in the State Legislature.
