

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases
2 - Research Triangle Institute International - AMBER Statement of Work - Department of Public
3 Health - \$113,581]

4 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**
5 **expend a grant in the amount of \$113,581 from the National Institute of Allergy and**
6 **Infectious Diseases through Research Triangle Institute International for participation**
7 **in a program, entitled “AMBER Statement of Work - San Francisco Department of**
8 **Public Health,” for the period of December 15, 2020, through July 31, 2025.**

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10 WHEREAS, The National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID), through
11 Research Triangle Institute (RTI) International as a pass-through entity, has agreed to fund
12 the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$113,581 for
13 participation in a program, entitled “AMBER Statement of Work (SOW) – San Francisco
14 Department of Public Health (SFDPH),” for the period of December 15, 2020, through July 31,
15 2025; and

16 WHEREAS, The scope of the work is to conduct iterative socio-behavioral research
17 with target end-user populations in the United States; and

18 WHEREAS, DPH will assess and survey high-risk populations for human
19 immunodeficiency virus (HIV) through a web-based Distributed Computing Environment
20 (DCE), and focus its socio-behavioral efforts on predominantly minority, sexually active, cis-
21 men who have sex with men as well as transgender women; and

22 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and

23 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received
24 the full award agreement on February 5, 2021, for a project start date of December 15, 2020;
25 and

1 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
2 \$22,716; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant
4 in the amount of \$113,581 from the NIAID through RTI International; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
6 expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
8 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the Grant Agreement being fully
10 executed by all parties, the Director of Health shall provide a copy to the Clerk of the Board of
11 Supervisors for inclusion in the official file.
