3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the Environment to accept and expend a**
4 **grant in the amount of \$15,000 from the San Francisco Foundation for providing**
5 **technical assistance to schools that are starting or maintaining organics waste**
6 **collection programs.**

8 WHEREAS, Based upon evaluation of responses to a San Francisco Foundation
9 request for proposals, the Department of the Environment School Education Program was
10 selected to be the recipient of \$15,000 in funding for technical assistance to schools with
11 organics waste collection programs; and,

12 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Department of the Environment will provide technical
13 assistance to schools starting and maintaining organics waste collection programs; and,

14 WHEREAS, on September 30, 2002 the City and County of San Francisco passed a
15 resolution adopting a goal of 75% waste diversion by 2010 which directed the Department of
16 the Environment to achieve this goal; and,

17 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,
18 therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of
20 the Department of the Environment to accept and expend funding of \$15,000 from the San
21 Francisco Foundation for technical assistance to schools for organics programs; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
23 indirect costs in the grant budget.






