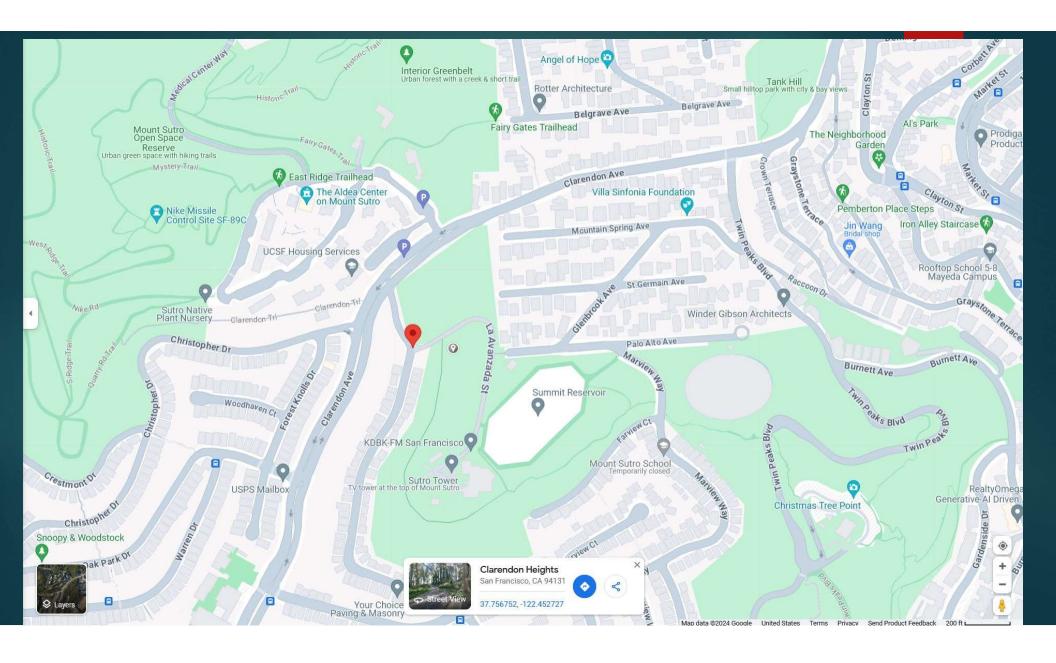

Background

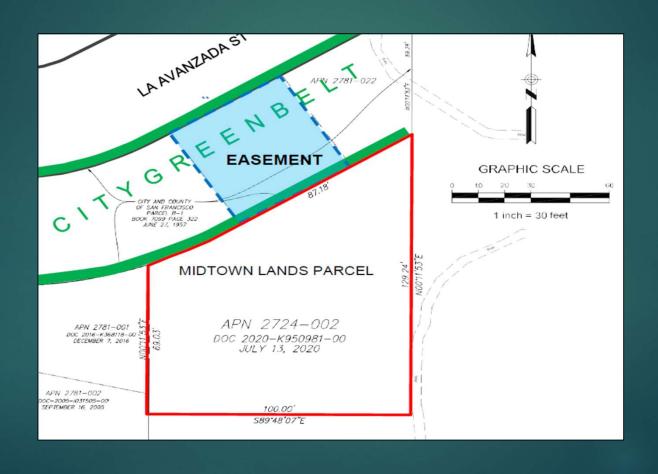
- Recreation and Parks has jurisdiction over 19 acres of undeveloped land between Twin Peaks and Mt. Sutro – the Interior Greenbelt - adjacent to the Midtown Terrace neighborhood in District 7.
- ➤ In 1957, a portion of Interior Greenbelt was deeded to City and a blanket easement running from an undeveloped parcel, through and down Greenbelt to Clarendon Street was reserved.
- After 1957, La Avanzada street was built, creating a right of way closer to parcel owner. City and parcel owner negotiated terms for access easement traversing a much smaller portion of Greenbelt.
- By 4-0 vote, Recreation and Parks Commission passed a resolution on July 20, 2023 recommending Board approval of the easement.

Terms of Agreement:

- Fixes and perfects access easement for private property owner, through 2,500 SF portion of Greenbelt, to La Avanzada St.
- Establishes quitclaim to remainder of original blanket easement area, thereby preserving greater portion of Greenbelt.
- Property owner accepts stewardship role, taking on maintenance responsibilities within Greenbelt.
- Indemnifies City against potential claims related to property owner's maintenance responsibilities.
- Allows property owner to run subsurface utilities through easement area to service parcel if and when developed.
