[Accept and Expend Grant - HIV Transmission Cluster Analysis to Inform Prevention - \$112,171]

Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$112,171 from The Regents of the University of California to participate in a program entitled "HIV Transmission Cluster Analysis to Inform Prevention" for the period of July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015.

WHEREAS, The Regents of the University of California is the recipient of a grant award from National Institutes of Health supporting the HIV Transmission Cluster Analysis to Inform Prevention grant; and

WHEREAS, With a portion of these funds, The Regents of the University of California has subcontracted with Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$112,171 for the period of July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, The Regents of the University of California requires the City to enter into an agreement (Agreement), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>150036</u>; which is hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of this project will significantly contribute to the field of HIV prevention by identifying drivers of the HIV epidemic and ways to interrupt forward transmission; and

WHEREAS, An Annual Salary Ordinance amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH for four existing positions, one Supervisor Physician Specialist (Job Class No. 2233) at .01 FTE, one Manager I (Job Class No. 0922) at .20 FTE for six months, one Health Program Coordinator II (Job Class No. 2591) at .35 FTE for five months and at
