

1 [Apply for Grant - United States Department of Housing and Urban Development - Continuum
2 of Care Program - Not to Exceed \$61,122,075]

3 **Resolution approving the 2024 grant application for the United States Department of
4 Housing and Urban Development Continuum of Care Program in an amount not to
5 exceed \$61,122,075; and fulfilling the Board of Supervisors review and approval
6 process for all annual or otherwise recurring grants of \$5,000,000 or more.**

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8 WHEREAS, Under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD")
9 2024 Continuum of Care ("CoC") grant application, the City and County of San Francisco (the
10 "City") and participating nonprofit entities are eligible to submit funding applications for funds
11 not to exceed \$61,122,075 to assist people experiencing homelessness; and

12 WHEREAS, The 2024 CoC Notice of Funding Opportunity ("2024 NOFO") was
13 released on July 31, 2024, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
14 in File No. 240993; and

15 WHEREAS, During the San Francisco 2023 CoC competition, San Francisco and its
16 nonprofits were awarded \$53,021,237 to support San Francisco's community efforts to end
17 homelessness; and

18 WHEREAS, HUD requires submission of the 2024 CoC Application by October 30,
19 2024, a copy of the application form is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File
20 No. 240993; and

21 WHEREAS, The 2024 CoC Application will be used by HUD to award both Fiscal Year
22 (FY) 2024-2025 and FY2025-2026 grant awards; and

23 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Local Homeless Coordinating Board ("LHCB") serves
24 as the lead entity that oversees the CoC process and programs, including the creation of
25 program priorities, funding categories, application guidelines, and scoring tools; and

1 WHEREAS, The LHCB plans to submit the 2024 CoC Application for a total amount not
2 to exceed \$61,122,075 of which an amount greater than \$5,000,000 passes through the
3 Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing (“HSH”); and

4 WHEREAS, The LHCB has been meeting monthly to advise on the City’s CoC
5 processes and programs, including receiving community input and participation in the
6 development of program priorities, application scoring criteria, and application guidelines and
7 process; and

8 WHEREAS, The LHCB approves the 2024 application process, scoring criteria, and
9 funding priorities for the 2024 CoC Application; and

10 WHEREAS, Under Ordinance No. 256-05, the appropriate City department shall submit
11 to the Board of Supervisors a Resolution articulating its grant application, as well as funding
12 categories, for all annual grant applications of \$5,000,000 or more; now, therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, That the LHCB and HSH are authorized to submit a 2024 CoC
14 Application for an amount not to exceed \$61,122,075.
