Attached please find an original and four copies of a proposed resolution for Board of Supervisors approval, which will allow the continuation of mental health services to children, youth and families and to adults by amending two of the Department of Public Health's current contracts with Richmond Area Multi-Services (RAMS) by a combined \$13,387,089.
