WHEREAS, Resolution 33-06 also urges the U.S. Senate to defeat HR4437 and all its provisions, and urged Senators Boxer and Feinstein to vote NO on the measure; and,

WHEREAS, During the week of March 21st, 23 Bay Area Residents, participated in a Hunger Strike in front of the Federal Building in order to bring public attention to the devastating impact of this bill, and to urge Federal Representatives to defeat similar measures in the House of Representatives; and,

WHEREAS, The Hunger Strikers needed to take in lots of fluids and therefore had to maintain a temporary restroom in close proximity, which required a Temporary Occupancy Permit from the Department of Public Works for the amount of \$362.29; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commend the 23 Hunger Strikers for their courage, sacrifice, and commitment to immigrant rights and social justice; and

RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors urge the Department of Public Works to waive the fee for the Temporary Occupancy permit issued to the Hungry Strikers.
