

1 [Terminating Domestic Violence Task Force]  
2 RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS NO. 131-86 AND 604-88, WHICH ESTABLISHED AND  
3 EXTENDED THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE TASK FORCE, THEREBY TERMINATING THE  
4 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE TASK FORCE; THANKING THE MEMBERS OF THE DOMESTIC  
5 VIOLENCE TASK FORCE FOR THEIR EFFORTS.

7 WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 131-86, the Board of Supervisors  
8 established the Domestic Violence Task Force, which was created for  
9 the purpose of gathering information on how the City may best effect  
10 the optimal response of the justice system in San Francisco to  
11 domestic violence, and coordinate this response with that of domestic  
12 violence community agencies; and

13 WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 604-88, the Board of Supervisors  
14 extended the operation of the Domestic Violence Task Force in order  
15 for the Board to be able to consider and discuss with the members of  
16 the Task Force the final report of the Domestic Violence Task Force  
17 that had been presented to the Board; and

18 WHEREAS, In 1995 the Board of Supervisors approved a new Article  
19 XIX for the City's Administrative Code, which created a Family  
20 Violence Advisory Council, a permanent advisory body to the Board of  
21 Supervisors, which submits recommendations to the Board for  
22 addressing the problems of family violence; and

23 WHEREAS, With the completion of the Task Force's report and the  
24 creation of the Family Violence Advisory Council, there is no further  
25 need for the Task Force to continue; now, therefore, be it




