

1 [Settlement of Lawsuit.]  
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3 **Ordinance authorizing the settlement of a lawsuit filed by the City and County of San**  
4 **Francisco against Kam Kong Tang and Kai Yuen Ng, former part owners of the King Tin**  
5 **Restaurant, for \$85,000.00; the lawsuit was filed on August 3, 2005 for violation of the**  
6 **City's Minimum Wage Ordinance, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. 433685,**  
7 **entitled City and County of San Francisco, et al. v. Kam Kong Tang and Kai Yuen Ng.**

8 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:  
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10 Section 1. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to settle the claims asserted by the  
11 City and County of San Francisco against Kam Kong Tang and Kai Yuen Ng in the action  
12 entitled City and County of San Francisco, et al. v. Kam Kong Tang and Kai Yuen Ng, San  
13 Francisco Superior Court, Case No. 433685, by accepting payment by the defendants in the  
14 amount of \$85,000.00. This amount shall be distributed to workers of the former King Tin  
15 Restaurant whom the City's Office of Labor Standards Enforcement determines to have valid  
16 claims for violations of the City's Minimum Wage Ordinance.

17 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on  
18 August 3, 2005, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: City and County of San  
19 Francisco, Plaintiff, and Kam Kong Tang and Kai Yuen Ng, Defendants.
