11	Section 1. In accordance with the provisions of Section 901, et seq. of Article 18,		
12	Chapter X, Part II of the San Francisco Municipal Code (Public Works Code), the Board of		
13	Supervisors does hereby create the following underground district:		
14	Underground District No. 355		
15	(Third Street/Bayshore Boulevard District)		
16	covering Third Street from the northerly line of Custer Avenue to the southerly line of Jerrold		
17	Avenue, Third Street from the northerly line of Williams Avenue to the southerly line of Meade		
18	Avenue, and Bayshore Boulevard from the northerly line of Blanken Avenue to the southerly		
19	line of Sunnydale Avenue south to the county line and Sunnydale Avenue from Bayshore Avenue to the		
20	<u>east end</u> .		
21	Section 2. The undergrounding of facilities within this underground district is in the		
22	general public interest in that said action will eliminate a heavy concentration of overhead		
23	wires along a heavily traveled street and is being done in conjunction with other public		
24	improvements.

1	Section 3. All work in connection with the undergrounding of facilities lying within thi		
2	underground district and subject to the laws with reference to underground districts is to be		
3	completed in accordance with the Department of Public Works' program; provided, howeve		
4	that said work shall be commenced at such time or according to such priority as the		
5	Department of Public Works has established.		
6	Section 4. The Board hereby requests that the utility companies providing the		
7	undergrounding of facilities within this underground district pay for up to 100 feet of each		
8	underground service lateral occasioned by the undergrounding.
