

1 [Accept & expend grant – Funding a Healthy San Francisco program evaluation.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**  
4 **and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$300,000 from the Blue Shield of**  
5 **California Foundation to fund a Healthy San Francisco program evaluation; for the**  
6 **period of January 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.**

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8 WHEREAS, The Blue Shield of California Foundation awarded DPH \$300,000 to fund  
9 an evaluation of the Healthy San Francisco program, for the 18 month period of January 1,  
10 2009 through June 30, 2010; and,

11 WHEREAS, Funds provided under this grant will be used to conduct an evaluation of  
12 Healthy San Francisco, a universal health access program that provides comprehensive  
13 health services to uninsured, adult San Francisco residents who are ineligible for public health  
14 insurance; and,

15 WHEREAS, This project budget includes \$280,000 in contractual services to conduct  
16 the program evaluation; and,

17 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required because funds are not used for  
18 staffing purposes; and,

19 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$20,000;

20 WHEREAS, As required by the funder, DPH allocated \$250,000 in matching funds;

21 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because the agreement  
22 was not executed until December 24, 2008 and the start date for the project is January 1,  
23 2009; now therefore, be it

24 **RESOLVED**, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a grant  
25 in the amount of \$300,000, for the period of January 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010; and, be it

1           FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
2           expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,  
3           be it

4           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
5           agreement on behalf of the City.
