[CEQA Findings]

Resolution adopting environmental findings pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act and State Guidelines in connection with adoption of a zoning map amendment for the 601 King Street Project.

WHEREAS, The 601 King Street Project is a proposed 61- to 65-foot tall 250-unit residential project on the Block 3800, Lots 1 and 2, bordered by King, Seventh, Barry and De Haro Streets in San Francisco, including a reclassification of the Height and Bulk District from 50-X to 65-X; and

WHEREAS, On May 27, 2000, the Planning Department released for public review and comment a Draft Environmental Impact Report for a previous version of the Project, which at the time was proposed as 238,000 gross square feet of business services space and a basement and ground floor garage and no Height and Bulk District reclassification; and,

WHEREAS, On July 6, 2000, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the Draft Environmental Impact Report and further written public comments were received until 5:00 p.m. on July 6, 2000; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department prepared a Final Environmental Impact Report ("FEIR") consisting of the Draft Environmental Impact Report, the comments received during the review period, any additional information that became available and the Draft Summary of Comments and Responses, all as required by law; and

WHEREAS, On August 17, 2000, the Planning Commission reviewed and considered the FEIR and, by Motion No. 15953 found that the contents of said report and the procedures through which the FEIR was prepared, publicized and reviewed complied with the provisions

of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and the CEQA Guidelines and Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission further found that the FEIR was adequate, accurate and objective and reflected the independent judgment and analysis of the Planning Commission, adopted findings of significant impacts associated with the Project and certified the completion of the FEIR all in compliance with CEQA and the CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, On June 13, 2002, the Planning Department issued an Addendum to the FEIR, which evaluated the currently proposed 61- to 65-foot tall 250-unit residential development, including a Height and Bulk District reclassification from 50-X to 65-X (the "Addendum") and which found that the revised Project would have no significant impacts not analyzed in the FEIR and that no further environmental review was required for the revised Project; and

WHEREAS, On March 13, 2003, the Planning Commission reviewed and considered the FEIR and Addendum, by Motion No. 16545 found that the contents of said reports and the procedures through which the FEIR and Addendum were prepared, publicized and reviewed complied with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and the CEQA Guidelines and Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission further found that the FEIR and Addendum were adequate, accurate and objective and reflected the independent judgment and analysis of the Planning Commission; adopted findings that the proposed mitigation measures will be implemented; imposed a Mitigation Monitoring Program attached to Motion No. 16545 as Exhibit C; and found that required mitigation measures are fully enforceable through and are included as conditions of approval of Motion No. 16545 or will be enforced through inclusion as conditions of approval in any building permits issued for the Project by the San Francisco

Department of Building Inspection, and that with the required mitigation measures, all potential Project impacts would be avoided or reduced to a less-than-significant level; and

WHEREAS, Said FEIR, Addendum, and other Project-related Planning Department files have been available for review by this Board of Supervisors and the public at the Department's offices at 1660 Mission Street, and those files are part of the record before this Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, Findings as required by CEQA regarding the mitigation measures and significant environmental impacts analyzed in the FEIR and Addendum and the Mitigation Monitoring Program imposed by the Planning Commission are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 012042, and designated Attachment A, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors reviewed and considered Planning

Commission Motion Nos. 15953 and 16545 certifying the FEIR and finding the FEIR and

Addendum adequate, accurate and objective, and reflecting the independent judgment and analysis of the Planning Commission; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors finds that (1) modifications incorporate into the Project will not require important revisions to the FEIR or Addendum due to the involvement of new significant environmental effects or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant effects; (2) no substantial changes have occurred with respect to the circumstances under which the Project is to be undertaken which would require major revisions to the FEIR or Addendum due to the involvement of new significant environmental effects, or a substantial increase in the severity of effects identified in the FEIR or Addendum; and (3) no new information of substantial importance to the Project has become available which would indicate that (a) the Project will have significant effects not discussed in the FEIR and Addendum, (b) significant environmental effects will be

substantially more severe; (c) mitigation measures or alternatives found not feasible which would reduce one or more significant effects have become feasible; or (d) mitigation measures or alternatives which are considerably different from those in the FEIR and Addendum would substantially reduce one or more significant effects on the environment; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered the FEIR and Addendum and hereby adopts the Project Findings on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 012042, and designated Attachment A, and incorporates the same in this resolution by this reference.
