

[FEDERAL FUNDING - COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT]

1 APPROVING THE AMENDMENT TO THE FINAL PROPOSAL AND ACTION
2 PLAN FOR SAN FRANCISCO'S 1999 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
3 GRANT PROGRAM, EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT PROGRAM, AND HOME
4 INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP RESULTING FROM A THREE MONTH
5 EXTENSION OF THE EXISTING 1999 PROGRAM YEAR.

6 WHEREAS, the Annual Action Plan for San Francisco was reviewed and
7 approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

8 WHEREAS, San Francisco's Consolidated Plan program April 1st start date
9 required approval of an expenditure schedule prior to the beginning of the citywide regular
10 budget process; and

11 WHEREAS, the development of San Francisco's community development
12 program would be enhanced through coordination with the City's other economic
13 development, job training, and neighborhood revitalization efforts; and

14 WHEREAS, San Francisco's community development program has encouraged its
15 non-profit community-based partners to leverage CDBG, ESG and HOME funding with
16 other local, state, federal and private resources; and

17 WHEREAS many of San Francisco's community development program partners
18 have, in fact, successfully secured funding from other locally-controlled funding streams,
19 and managing multiple contracts with conflicting fiscal years imposes an unnecessary
20 administrative burden on these organizations; and

21 WHEREAS sufficient funds have been identified in order to extend funding for
22 basic operating expenses for existing projects providing direct services to lower income
23 persons in San Francisco's 1999 Action Plan; now, therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby amend the Action Plan
25 for San Francisco's Community Development Block Grant Program, Emergency Shelter
Grant Program, and the HOME Investment Partnership.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit all
necessary documentation and certifications required by the U.S. Department of Housing
and Urban Development.




