WHEREAS, San Francisco's community development program has encouraged its non-profit community-based partners to leverage CDBG, ESG and HOME funding with other local, state, federal and private resources; and

WHEREAS many of San Francisco's community development program partners have, in fact, successfully secured funding from other locally-controlled funding streams, and managing multiple contracts with conflicting fiscal years imposes an unnecessary administrative burden on these organizations; and

WHEREAS sufficient funds have been identified in order to extend funding for basic operating expenses for existing projects providing direct services to lower income persons in San Francisco's 1999 Action Plan; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby amend the Action Plan for San Francisco's Community Development Block Grant Program, Emergency Shelter Grant Program, and the HOME Investment Partnership.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit all necessary documentation and certifications required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
