8 broadcasting after 52 years in the business, having spent the last 34 years as
9 the leading voice at KCBS All News 74; and

10 WHEREAS, Al Hart studied journalism and broadcasting at the University
11 of Minnesota before starting his career at WOBT in Wisconsin; and

12 WHEREAS, First hired at KCBS in 1966 as the producer of "McElhatton in
13 the Morning," Al Hart became a news anchor in 1968, taking over the top
14 morning slot in 1976; and

16 WHEREAS, Since then, Al Hart has been "the voice" of KCBS, widely
17 respected as a straightforward professional who delivers the news with warmth
18 and sincerity; and

20 WHEREAS, Al Hart is a winner of the Lifetime Achievement Award from
21 the Society of Professional Journalists and he has been a key part of a news
22 team that has won every major national broadcasting honor in the last decade,
23 including a Peabody, duPont-Columbia, Sigma Delta Chi and National Headliner

Award, and two Edward R. Murrow Awards for Overall Excellence in Broadcast
Journalism; and

WHEREAS, Al Hart will be missed by KCBS and his 600,000 plus weekly
listeners; now, therefore, be it


