4 **Resolution appointing Catherine Smith, Michael Goldstein, Patt Denning, Camilla**
5 **Norman Field, and Richard Rendon, terms ending January 1, 2009, to the Community**
6 **Oversight Committee Regarding Enforcement of Marijuana Offenses; residency**
7 **requirement waived.**

9 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
10 does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the
11 Community Oversight Committee Regarding Enforcement of Marijuana Offenses, pursuant to
12 the provisions of the San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 12X.6, for the terms
13 specified:

14 Catherine Smith, new appointment, seat 3, must be a representative of a medical
15 cannabis dispensary operating in San Francisco, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term
16 ending January 1, 2009.

17 Michael Goldstein, new appointment, seat 4, must be a civil liberties advocate, for the
18 unexpired portion of a two-year term ending January 1, 2009.

19 Patt Denning (residency requirement waived), new appointment, seat 5, must be a
20 harm reduction practitioner, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending January 1,
21 2009.

22 Camilla Norman Field, new appointment, seat 6, must be a representative of a drug
23 policy reform organization, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending January 1,
24 2009.

1 Richard Rendon (residency requirement waived), new appointment, seat 7, must be a
2 representative from any of the following categories: juvenile justice advocate, advocate for
3 homeless persons, resident of public housing, or representative of an organization providing
4 services to or advocating on behalf of residents of public housing in San Francisco, for the
5 unexpired portion of a two-year term ending January 1, 2009; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 7 1. The membership of the Community Oversight Committee Regarding Enforcement of
8 Marijuana Offenses has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County
9 of San Francisco.
- 10 2. Applicants Patt Denning and Richard Rendon, new appointees, who are not residents of
11 San Francisco, are persons with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the
12 Community Oversight Committee Regarding Enforcement of Marijuana Offenses.
- 13 3. The Community Oversight Committee Regarding Enforcement of Marijuana Offenses has
14 attempted to fill the positions, for which Patt Denning and Richard Rendon were
15 nominated, with individuals who are City residents and who have the specific experience,
16 skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee
17 has certified that Patt Denning and Richard Rendon are qualified to serve on the
18 Community Oversight Committee Regarding Enforcement of Marijuana Offenses.
- 19 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there are no other
20 possible representatives, who are residents of San Francisco and who have the specific
21 experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by these applicants, and who are willing to
22 serve on the Community Oversight Committee Regarding Enforcement of Marijuana
23 Offenses at this time; and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency
25 requirement for Patt Denning and Richard Rendon, as allowed in cases where no qualified

1 City residents, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter
2 that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by
3 legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San
4 Francisco.
