

1 [Resolution authorizing City officials the ability to execute homeland security grants]
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3 **Resolution authorizing designated City and County officials to execute and file on**
4 **behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, a public entity established under the**
5 **laws of the State of the California, any applications or agreements and to take any**
6 **actions necessary to obtain federal financial assistance provided by the federal**
7 **Department of Homeland Security and sub-granted through the State of California,**
8 **including the following grants: State Homeland Security Grant Program, Metropolitan**
9 **Medical Response System, and Citizen Corps Program.**
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11 WHEREAS, The State of California, through various federal homeland security grant
12 programs, provides support for the development and maintenance of the capability of local
13 jurisdictions to prepare for and respond to terrorist attacks using weapons of mass destruction
14 and provides for the dispersal of federal funds provided for this purpose; and

15 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has participated in these programs
16 since their inception and deems participation in these programs as vital to the continued well-
17 being of its residents and visitors, property and environment; and,

18 WHEREAS, The State of California requires that San Francisco's agents be named in
19 a governing body resolution, now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, a
21 public entity established under the laws of the State of California, authorizes the Executive
22 Director of the Department of Emergency Management, or in his or her absence, the Chief
23 Financial Officer of the Department of Emergency Management or the Controller of the City
24 and County of San Francisco, to execute for and on behalf of the City and County of San
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1 Francisco any applications or agreements and to take any actions necessary to seek or obtain
2 federal financial assistance provided by the federal Department of Homeland Security and
3 sub-granted through the State of California under the Homeland Security Grant Program,
4 including the following grants: State Homeland Security Grant Program, Metropolitan Medical
5 Response System, and Citizen Corps Program.

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
