Linda Fadeke Richardson serves as President of the Treasure Island Development Authority (TIDA) and Chair of its Housing, Infrastructure, Transportation, and Sustainability (HITS) Committee. She brings over twenty-five years of experience in large-scale, complex public-private partnerships, with a particular focus on mixed-use and waterfront development.

In her TIDA roles, Linda has guided the development of the Treasure Island and Yerba Buena Island projects. These initiatives are making significant contributions to San Francisco's economic revitalization and sustainability. She has worked diligently to ensure project milestones are met while collaborating with city leadership to expand housing opportunities. Treasure Island represents a critical opportunity for San Francisco to meet its mandated Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA).

The combined Treasure Island/Yerba Buena Island mixed-use development will generate over 10,000 housing units at full build-out, along with more than 300 acres of parks and open space. To date, the projects have already delivered substantial workforce training, employment, and local hiring opportunities for residents of Treasure Island and the broader San Francisco community.

As a longtime Bayview–Hunters Point and India Basin resident, Linda has played a central role in decades-long community planning efforts to revitalize San Francisco's southeastern sector. She has held numerous leadership roles, applying her development expertise to shape master land use and economic development plans, spearhead workforce initiatives, and provide technical guidance on complex development matters.

Linda also served on the Port of San Francisco Waterfront Plan Working Group and chaired its Transportation Subcommittee. She made tremendous contributions to the comprehensive land use, transportation, and resilience policies that guided long-term capital planning, revenue generation, waterfront access, and climate adaptation strategies.

She is also the Principal of ADR Continental Group, a full-service, woman-owned consulting firm specializing in community development and revitalization, housing, project management, strategic planning, stakeholder engagement, public participation, communications, and crisis management.
