4 **Resolution authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Works to accept**  
5 **retroactively and expend up to \$15,983 in federal Emergency Relief funds with required**  
6 **local matching funds of \$2,071 for reconstruction of the hillside at San Jose Avenue**  
7 **from Richland Avenue to Highland Avenue in the City and County of San Francisco.**

9 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. 744-99  
10 on August 2, 1999 authorizing the Director of Public Works to accept retroactively and expend  
11 up to \$110,027 in federal Emergency Relief funds for engineering and reconstruction of the  
12 hillside for the protection of life, safety, and property at San Jose Avenue from Richland  
13 Avenue to Highland Avenue; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Federal Highway Administration subsequently authorized the  
15 California Department of Transportation to provide an additional \$15,983 in federal  
16 Emergency Relief funds for the aforementioned project; and

17 WHEREAS, Federal grant regulations require a local match of \$2,071 and indirect  
18 costs are not allowed, and

19 WHEREAS, The non-federal share of \$2,071 will be paid for with monies from the  
20 Department of Public Works Funds; and,


21 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works (DPW) advertised the aforementioned  
22 project in August 2001 with bids being received on September 19, 2001; and,

23 WHEREAS, Under City rules and regulations the Department has identified an  
24 apparent low bidder and is prepared to award the contract to prevent further hillside


1 destabilization that could potentially jeopardize life, safety, and property at the affected area  
2 of San Jose Avenue; now therefore be it

3 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Department of  
4 Public Works to accept retroactively and expend \$15,983 in federal Emergency Relief funds  
5 with required local matching funds of \$2,071 to reconstruct the hillside for the protection of  
6 life, safety, and property at San Jose Avenue from Richland Avenue to Highland Avenue  
7 within the City and County of San Francisco and to execute all documents therefore.




