16	The Commission shall consist of 15 members. Each member of the Commission				
17	shall be an honorably discharged veteran of the armed forces of the United States of America;				
18	provided, however, that this requirement is not intended and shall not be applied to exclude any person				
19	from membership on the Commission who was discharged from the armed forces of the United States of				
20	America on account of his or her sexual orientation, or on account of his or her statements or conduct				
21	evidencing that orientation. Eleven of the members shall be appointed by the Board of				
22	Supervisors and four of the members shall be appointed by the Mayor as follows:				
23	(a) At least three woman veterans;

2	America and is suffering under a physical disability arising from that service, in accordance

4		<u>(c)</u>	Every	person seeking to be appointed to the Commission shall submit at least	
5	one of the fo	one of the following to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors at the time that person submits an			
6	application for appointment to the Commission:				
7			(i)	a copy of his or her DD-214 discharge sheet;	
8			(ii)	equivalent written evidence of service in and honorable discharge from	
9				the armed forces of the United States of America; or	
10			(iii)	equivalent written evidence of service in and discharge from the armed	
11				forces of the United States of America solely on account of the person's	
12				sexual orientation and/or the person's statements or conduct evidencing	
13				that orientation.
