

[Amendment Agreement - Retroactive - City of Brisbane and Guadalupe Valley Municipal Improvement District - Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement for Sewer Service - At No Cost]

Resolution retroactively approving and authorizing the General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement for Sewer Service with the City of Brisbane and Guadalupe Valley Municipal Improvement District, increasing the duration of the original agreement from July 31, 2025 to the earlier of December 31, 2027, or until the execution of a new long-term agreement, pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118.

WHEREAS, On July 31, 1995, by Board of Supervisors Resolution No. 560-95, the City and County of San Francisco (City) executed the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement for Sewer Service (JEPA) with the City of Brisbane (Brisbane) and the Guadalupe Valley Municipal Improvement District (District) for a 30-year nonrenewable term; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the JEPA, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) provides wastewater treatment and disposal services to Brisbane and the District; and

WHEREAS, The JEPA also establishes, among other terms and conditions, calculation and payment of sewer service rates, wastewater discharge limits, and compliance with federal and State wastewater discharge laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS, With the JEPA expiring, the SFPUC began negotiations with Brisbane and District to execute a new long-term agreement; and

WHEREAS, Due to significant updates to calculation of sewer rates; changes in regulatory requirements; the engagement of City of Daly City and Bayshore Sanitary District in negotiations, both of which also send wastewater to the City's sewer system for treatment and

1 disposal; and unforeseen administrative delays, the parties were not able to timely execute a
2 new long-term agreement prior to the July 31, 2025, expiration of the JEPA; and

3 WHEREAS, Since the expiration of the JEPA, the parties have continued to operate
4 under its terms and conditions; and

5 WHEREAS, To memorialize this approach and ensure continuity of service, SFPUC,
6 Brisbane, and the District desire to retroactively extend the term of the JEPA until the earlier
7 of December 31, 2027, or when a new agreement is executed; and

8 WHEREAS, No other changes to the JEPA are proposed; the existing agreements with
9 the City of Daly City and the Bayshore Sanitary District have terms that automatically renew
10 and are not expiring at this time; and

11 WHEREAS, On May 7, 2026, by Resolution No. 2026-11 and Resolution No. 2026-1,
12 Brisbane's City Council and Guadalupe Valley Municipal Improvement District's Board of
13 Directors approved the amendment to extend the term of the JEPA; and

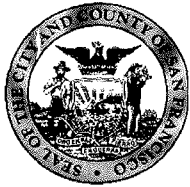
14 WHEREAS, Pursuant to the JEPA, Brisbane and the District are required to pay the
15 SFPUC for wastewater treatment and disposal services, and Brisbane and the District are
16 also solely responsible for the operation and maintenance of their facilities; and

17 WHEREAS, Execution of this amendment will ensure the SFPUC continues receiving
18 revenue for providing wastewater treatment and disposal services to Brisbane and the District;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, On May 26, 2026, by Resolution No. 26-0079, the SFPUC Commission
21 authorized the General Manager of the SFPUC to execute Amendment No. 1 to the JEPA
22 with Brisbane and the District, retroactively increasing the duration of the original agreement
23 from July 31, 2025 to the earlier of December 31, 2027, or until the execution of a new long-
24 term agreement, pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Amendment in
2 substantially the form contained in File No. 260674; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the General
4 Manager of the SFPUC to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Joint Exercise of Powers
5 Agreement for Sewer Service with the City of Brisbane and Guadalupe Valley Municipal
6 Improvement District, retroactively increasing the duration of the original agreement from
7 July 31, 2025 to earlier of December 31, 2027, or until the execution of a new long-term
8 agreement.
