WHEREAS, San Francisco applied and was awarded on July 14, 2004, two-hundred and fifty-thousand dollars (\$250,000); and



RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes MOCJ to retroactively accept and expend \$250,000 from BJA, Office of Justice Programs, to administer the 2004 Sex Offender Management Discretionary Grant Program.






