1 [Approval of a 90-Day Extension for Landmark Designation - Pacific States Telephone and  
2 Telegraph, National Urban League - 2015 Steiner Street (File No. 260255)]

3 **Resolution extending by 90 days the prescribed time within which the Historic**  
4 **Preservation Commission may respond to a landmark designation of the Pacific States**  
5 **Telephone and Telegraph, National Urban League, located at 2015 Steiner Street,**  
6 **Assessor’s Parcel Block No. 0655, Lot No. 006, from the Board of Supervisors (File No.**  
7 **260255).**

9 WHEREAS, On March 10, 2026, Supervisor Sherrill introduced legislation to initiate the  
10 landmark designation of the Pacific States Telephone and Telegraph, National Urban League  
11 located at 2015 Steiner Street, Assessor’s Parcel Block No. 0655, Lot No. 006; and

12 WHEREAS, On March 23, 2026, the Land Use and Transportation Committee referred  
13 the Resolution for adoption at the next board meeting; and

14 WHEREAS, On March 24, 2026, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Resolution  
15 to initiate landmark designation, and on March 26, 2026, Resolution No. 166-26 became  
16 effective (Board File No. 260255); and

17 WHEREAS, On April 9, 2026, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors referred the  
18 proposed landmark designation to the Historic Preservation Commission and Planning  
19 Commission; and

20 WHEREAS, The Historic Preservation Commission shall, in accordance with Planning  
21 Code, Section 1004.2(b), respond to landmark designations initiations from the Board within  
22 90 days from the date of referral of the proposed landmark designation or modification by the  
23 Board to the Commission; and

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1           WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code, Section 1004.2(b) may, by  
2 Resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Historic Preservation Commission is  
3 to render its decision; and

4           WHEREAS, Absent an extension, the Historic Preservation Commission's deadline to  
5 act to approve, disapprove, or modify the proposed designation is July 8, 2026, or 90 days  
6 from the referral of the Resolution to the Historic Preservation Commission, which occurred on  
7 April 9, 2026; and

8           WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Planning  
9 Department and Historic Preservation Commission additional time to review the proposed  
10 landmark designation and render its decision; now, therefore be it

11           RESOLVED, That by this Resolution, the Board hereby extends the prescribed time  
12 within which the Historic Preservation Commission may render its decision on the proposed  
13 landmark designation for approximately 90 additional days, or until October 6, 2026.
