

1 [Accept-Expend Bay Area Air Quality Management District Grant]
2 AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO RETROACTIVELY
3 ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$136,500 FROM THE
4 TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR CLEAN AIR IN THE BAY AREA FOR THE STRIPING OF
5 BIKE LANES IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS AND WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS.

6 WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 434 created the Transportation Fund for
7 Clean Air in the Bay Area, and provided authority to the Bay Area Air
8 Quality Management District ("the District") to impose up to a \$4.00
9 surcharge on motor vehicle registration fees within its jurisdiction,
10 to be used to implement specified transportation control measures;
11 and,

12 WHEREAS, On October 16, 1991, the District approved a \$2.00
13 surcharge on motor vehicle registration fees, and raised the
14 surcharge to \$4.00 effective April 1, 1993; and,

15 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco supports the Bay
16 Area Clean Air Plan; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic has developed a
18 project for FY 1998-99 AB434 program funding to stripe bike lanes on
19 the following streets:

20 Seventh St. (Northbound; Bryant-Market Sts.; 0.7 mile)

21 Post St. (Presidio Ave.-Laguna St.; 1.0 mile)

22 Sagamore St. (Eastbound; Plymouth-Capitol Aves.; 0.2 mile)

23 Sickles Ave. (Westbound; Alemany Bl.-San Jose Ave.; 0.1 mile); and,

24 WHEREAS, The District has included a total of \$136,500 in its
25 recommended list of projects to cover the costs of this project; and,

1 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved Resolution 531-98 on
2 June 29, 1998, authorizing the Chief Administrative Officer to apply
3 for grant support from the Transportation Fund for Clean Air in the
4 Bay Area for programs and projects to reduce air pollution from motor
5 vehicles, including this project, copy which is on file with the
6 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 98-1049; and,

7 WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission adopted Resolution No.
8 121-99-PTC at its meeting of March 2, 1999 authorizing the Executive
9 Director of The Department Of Parking And Traffic or his designee, to
10 accept and expend \$136,500 from The Transportation Fund For Clean Air
11 In The Bay area to stripe bike lanes in various locations; and,

12 WHEREAS calculating and claiming indirect costs using the
13 methodology required by the District would require additional expense
14 and reduce the funds available for program delivery; and,

15 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Bicycle Advisory Committee approved
16 this bicycle project at their July 23, 1998 meeting; now, therefore,
17 be it


18 RESOLVED, That the Department of Parking and Traffic be
19 retroactively authorized to accept and expend a grant in the amount
20 of \$136,500, from the Transportation Fund For Clean Air In The Bay
21 Area for the striping of bike lanes in various locations, waiving
22 indirect costs; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That although the City has incurred no
24 legal obligation, the Board of Supervisors does hereby ratify the
25 action previously taken.


