WHEREAS. The first complaint against International Business Machines was registered at the Department of Public Works hotline at 28-CLEAN on April 18, 2001; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works immediately called IBM and ordered them to cease and desist from their advertising campaign; and

WHEREAS, On Friday April 27, 2001 Department of Public Works Crews were dispatched to clean the four corners of Second Street and Townsend Street; and,

WHEREAS. On Saturday April 28, 2001 the IBM stencils were replaced at these exact locations and additional stencils appeared along Market Street from Steuart to Gough Street; and,

WHEREAS, IBM has refused to disclose all of the locations of the stencils and the local sub-contractor that was used for the stenciling; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED. That the City Attorney and the District Attorney prepare felony charges pursuant to California Penal Code 594(b)(2) and Public Works Code Section 184.57; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Works the Department of Public Works shall track all costs associated with the removal of stencils so that a proper billing can be made to the responsible parties; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That IBM immediately disclose the locations of the sidewalk graffiti and that if the information is not forthcoming that the City Attorney and the District Attorney prepare a subpoena requiring that the information be forthcoming; and be it
