WHEREAS, The existing sewer had bricks missing in the invert and bulging side walls, and immediate replacement was required in order to protect the health, welfare, and property of the Citizens of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for Contract No. CW-233E, "Intersection of Howard and First Streets Emergency Sewer Replacement" to replace the existing 3' x 5' brick sewer with approximately 75 linear feet of 16-inch diameter PEP sewer, 45 linear feet of 30-inch diameter PEP sewer, and 13 linear feet of 30-inch RCP or VCP sewer at the intersection of Howard and First Streets; and

WHEREAS, Construction is expected to begin the first week of April 1999, and the time allowed for completion of this contract is 14 calendar days; and

WHEREAS, Because this was an emergency contract, HRC subcontracting goals were not established by the HRC Contract Compliance Officer assigned to monitor the Clean Water sewer replacement program; and

WHEREAS, The cost of the project is projected to be \$113,800.00, of which \$88,150.00 is for the construction contract. Funds are available from the Repair and Replacement Fund (Fund 5C/CPF/R&R, FAMIS Project No. CENRNRR02440, Job Order No. 1790N); and

WHEREAS, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.30 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an emergency; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the emergency work to replace the structurally inadequate sewer at the intersection of Howard and First Streets.
