WHEREAS, Under the terms of the agreement, the network will buy more advertising time in minority media and will use more minority media placement firms; and,

WHEREAS, The joint venture has prompted another network, the National Broadcasting Company (NBC), to initiate a similar pact with the nation's oldest civil rights organization; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco extends its highest commendation to the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People and the American Broadcasting Company for its efforts to increase the number of people of color employed by the network.
