WHEREAS, The City has prepared and approved an Energy Element to the Comprehensive Plan of the City and County of San Francisco which in part, calls for the establishment of an energy management program for the City's municipal sector; and,

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Energy Conservation is developing implementation tools to deliver municipal energy retrofit services in the most cost-effective manner; and,

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes \$75,000 for salaries and general operating expenses; now, be it

RESOLVED, That the General Manager of the Public Utilities Commission be authorized to apply for, accept and expend \$75,000 in grant funding from the U.S. Department

of Energy and the Urban Consortium (through its fiscal agent, the City of Chicago) to continue its energy management activities; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That although the City had to previously submit the grant application to meet a deadline, yet incurred no legal obligation, the Board of Supervisors does hereby ratify the action previously taken.
