7 WHEREAS, For the last 12 years, Marie Jobling served as the Executive Director of  
8 PECC, a program determined to improving the quality of life for elders and adults with  
9 disabilities through the expansion of community-based care systems; and,

10 WHEREAS, Several programs established through the efforts of PECC such as Senior  
11 Survival School, Digital Bridge Project, Home care Empowerment, Research, & Organizing  
12 (HERO), and Healthcare Action Team (HAT) served as models throughout the state and  
13 empowered seniors and caregivers to advocate on their own behalf; and,

14 WHEREAS, Ms. Jobling empowered senior citizens, persons with disabilities, and  
15 caregivers to improve the quality of their lives through understanding issues, encouraging  
16 leadership development and collaborative action; and,

17 WHEREAS, Ms. Jobling's efforts led to changes such as the creation of the IHSS Public  
18 Authority, designing and funding of a community-based workers registry/referral system,  
19 increased wages for home care workers, and the expansion of IHSS services; now, therefore,  
20 be it,

22 Marie Jobling for her 12 years of services and leadership in Planning for Elders in Central City
