Representation matters. The late Rose Pak, a longstanding leader within the Chinese community once said, "If you don't have a seat at the table, you're on the menu." I want to serve on the Redistricting Task Force to ensure that San Francisco's marginalizes communities don't end up "on the menu" during the redistricting process. I am gay, cis-male, Asian nonprofit worker who was born in San Francisco. I represent so many dynamic communities that our city is trying to protect. As a 3rd generation San Franciscian, I know the struggles that long-term residents face. I am a nonprofit worker, so I myself am low-income. I understand the intense pressure to remain in San Francisco with rising costs. I am part of the city's vibrant LGBTQ+ community. I've been a member of the Harvey Milk LGBTQ Democratic Club since 2016.

Business and/or professional experience:

I graduated with a BS in General Biology from UC San Diego. I held various positions in the biotech and pharmaceutical field for 3 years. I then received a certification to teach English and did so in Taipei, Taiwan for 2 years. For the past five years, I have dedicated my career and personal time to advocating on behalf of disadvantaged communities, especially the Chinese community. Since 2017, I have worked at Chinatown Community Development Center. I have personally witnessed the systemic disparities that immigrants, low-income families, and seniors face. My current role is an Asset Management Coordinator. I manage relationships with external partners and analyze revenue streams involved with low income housing projects. I see the hard numbers everyday--low-income seniors barely managing to afford \$300/month in rent for a tiny SRO room on a fixed income.

If selected for Redistricting Task Force, I will be a strong advocate for the communities that are unable to have a voice and are too often overlooked in the halls of power.

Civic Activities:

Since 2016, I have been highly active in the San Francisco political landscape. For the past four years, I have worked at Chinatown Community Development Center, an institution within the Chinese community. I know intimately the issues facing Chinatown and the Chinese community with regard to public safety, affordable housing, transportation, land use, and open space. During every election cycle since 2016, I have volunteered to canvass neighborhoods in order to inform voters about how items on the ballot will impact their lives. I am also the Vice President of the Rose Pak Democratic (RPDC), advocating on behalf of San Francisco's API communities regarding of public safety, language access, affordable housing, and public transportation. RPDC amplifies and uplifts the voices of working class immigrants who are often unable to participate in the political process.



I am excited to be able to contribute to redistricting process. It is very important that the district lines are redrawn in a balanced and fair manner and that the new district lines reflect the changes in population in our city. I am confident that my knowledge of the city, its neighborhoods, its diverse communities and geography would help achieve these goals.

My lived experience, as a Mexican immigrant of a predominant Indigenous (Native American) background that is not yet a United States citizen, member of a non-English speaking household living in a below-market rate inclusionary housing unit in the South of Market, coupled with significant and deep experience in civic engagement with communities of color and working-class San Franciscans, would bring an important perspective to the redistricting process.

Business and/or professional experience:

I have been involved in civic engagement for many years here in San Francisco:

- As community organizer for the SF Bicycle Coalition from 2012 through 2016, I managed the organization's member-informed and elected-board-led endorsement and engagement process. Work included ensuring members were informed on races and candidates and voted in the election.
- As political coordinator for the San Francisco Rising Alliance from 2016 through 2018, I managed its civic engagement programs each election cycle. Work included engagement of working-class communities in District 5, 6, 9, 10 and 11 around priority ballot measures and general political education.
- As political organizer for SEIU Local 1021, I have worked to support our membership's political education in San Francisco and in the North Bay. Work included building our committee on political education, increasing electoral engagement within our membership and staffing the committees through each political cycle.

In addition to this work, I worked for a decade in Switzerland in the technology sector, either as a developer or in business development for technology startups.

I was formerly an elected member of the SF Bicycle Coalition board of directors and of the Sierra Club San Francisco Group's Executive Committee. I am currently a member of the East Cut Community Benefit District's Board of Directors. Sixteen years ago, my family and I immigrated from Taishan, China to San Francisco and settled in Visitacion Valley. I love the Southeast of our city and am proud to have attended public schools in the community. I first began organizing in high school through the Chinese Progressive Association fighting wage theft, educating fellow youth, and advocating for affordable housing alongside Latinx and Pacific Islander allies. As a queer young immigrant woman living in this neighborhood with parents barely getting by and making a little over minimum wage, I see that this district has many families going through similar circumstances. I am applying to be on the Redistricting Task Force to ensure that families in each district are receiving the best representation in the City and County of San Francisco.

Business and/or professional experience:

Professionally, I have staffed local political campaigns and served as a legislative fellow with the Board of Supervisors. Currently, I am a Program Coordinator with the Felton Institute, a non-profit in the Bay Area. In the agency, I manage a program called the Tech Squad, which trains low-income older adults and behavioral health clients with their technological devices. The program also connects them with broadband services and devices if they do not already have them. This program is essential to many families and individuals because the Shelter-In-Place policy during the COVID-19 pandemic forced them to access services online, which many could not and were not able to do.

As a multiracial individual, I have always been sensitive to the concerns of a diverse set of communities. My mother is Jewish and my father is a Filipino immigrant.

Over the past few years, San Francisco, California, and the United States have seen a shocking rise in Antisemitic and Anti-Asian hate crimes. My heart stopped when I saw the pictures of Danny Yu Chang, a Filipino-Chinese travel agent, after he was brutally attacked on Market Street. In Danny, I saw my father, and I was reminded of my dad's story of being mugged his first week in California, when he moved here in the 1980s. In that moment, I saw how this city I've grown to love has failed to look out for its vulnerable populations, too often not providing them a necessary seat at the table for fundamental decisions that affect their day-to-day lives. Given that Asians and Multiracial individuals are the demographics with the fastest growing populations in San Francisco, I believe that it's important that these groups are given a voice at the redistricting table.

Now San Francisco is an incredibly diverse city, with fantastic individuals from across the globe and identity spectrums welcomed here. It's important that the Redistricting Task Force take into account all aspects of diversity in drawing up the new District maps. My data analysis skills, knowledge of district compactness, and understanding of San Francisco's demography provide me with the ability to ensure such maps are representative of all aspects of San Francisco's great diversity, while maintaining geographic contiguity.

Business and/or professional experience:

I currently work as a Data Scientist for Retool, a company that makes it easier for software engineers to build reliable internal tools. My primary responsibilities are to analyze data and generate quantitative insights for the business.

Previously I worked as a Data Scientist for 5.5 years at Gusto, a small business payroll, benefits, and HR software services company. As part of my work at Gusto, I analyzed data regarding employee turnover at small businesses, culminating in an op-ed for CNBC examining high attrition rates for low-wage employees. This op-ed was cited by Senator Elizabeth Warren in letters to Amazon and Walmart in March 2020, asking for full paid sick-leave policies for their employees at the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic in the United States.

Before then, I worked as a Data & Policy Analyst for 2 years at Acumen LLC, a company that provides impartial data-driven analysis to government agencies to help inform health care and social policy. At Acumen, I primarily focused on detecting Medicaid Fraud, developing anomaly detection algorithms to identify doctors engaging in fraudulent, wasteful and abusive billing practices.

Civic Activities:

For all my life, I've viewed democracy as the foundational element for ensuring society protects civil liberties and human rights. A healthy democracy ensures that people have a voice in the policies their government pursues, and who represents them at the table.

Unfortunately, minority groups are often underrepresented in elected government positions, with majority groups able to win single-member districts at a disproportionate rate. It is through the process of redistricting that a government can ensure that minorities are represented in a representative democracy. Furthermore, these minority interests can be shut out of the process via gerrymandering, where those in power can draw up maps to ensure their constituency retains an electoral advantage.

It is this injustice that motivated me to research redistricting in college. At the University of California, Los Angeles, I was lucky enough to conduct such research with Political Science professor Jeff Lewis, the president of the Society for Political Methodology. Under Professor Lewis' guidance, I read through dozens of Supreme Court cases related to redistricting including Baker v. Carr and Karcher v. Daggett, gaining an understanding of how the legal system viewed gerrymandering and compactness of districts. With Prof. Lewis, I worked to develop statistical programs to assess the compactness of districts. In this process, I learned about a wide range of compactness measures and how they're applied in assessing maps for potential violations of the Voting Rights Act. What we discovered was that most compactness measures suffer from a flaw in that they do not take into account the distribution of a population within a district. For example, District 1 and District 4 in San Francisco could be merged together via Golden Gate Park into a shape that most measures would deem "compact". But because of the minimal population in Golden Gate Park, it would be hard to argue that such a district is truly compact. Thus, we worked to consider more population-based compactness measures to combine with traditional geographic compactness stats.

It is from these experiences that I learned the importance of redistricting, and the impact it has on our governance and democracy. Through my research I have gained a deep appreciation for the broad diversity of cities, and how that diversity changes over time. In San Francisco, I've witnessed an ever-changing city, with communities constantly in flux. We are a city of immigrants and multi-generation locals, old and young, wealthy and low-income. This diversity is what makes our city stronger, and I believe it's important to ensure that all communities are given proper representation in our local government. Because of this, I would be honored to serve on the San Francisco Redistricting Task Force.

I have also served as a Policy Analysis Intern in the Office of Illinois State Representative Daniel Biss, where I researched labor mobility.

I previously applied for appointment to the Redistricting Task Force via the Elections Commission, and was selected as a top alternate.


