6 September 2, 1969; and

7 WHEREAS, Nick has served with dedication and great distinction at Mission Station  
8 from 1970-1977 and from 1999 until his retirement on February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2006, also serving at  
9 Potrero Station, Ingleside Station, the Inspectors Bureau, Vice, and the Special investigations  
10 Bureau; and

11 WHEREAS, Nick is revered by his colleagues for his innate detective abilities and finely  
12 honed police skills, as exemplified by his plainclothes work in the Ingleside 35 car which set  
13 the standard against which others are measured; and

14 WHEREAS, Nick was promoted to Sergeant in 1999 and returned to Mission Station to  
15 serve as the Special Event Sergeant Extraordinaire—coordinating Cinco de Mayo, Carnaval  
16 and Halloween with incredible patience, attention to detail, dedication to public safety and  
17 sometimes even flexibility; and

18 WHEREAS, Nick's ability to constructively engage with community members,  
19 businesses, and City Departments to create safe, vibrant and unique Civic events has  
20 fostered public/private partnerships that benefited Mission District residents; and

21 WHEREAS, Nick has been awarded Police Officer of the Year on three occasions, has  
22 received 5 Meritorious Conduct Awards and 10 Police Commission Commendations; and

23 WHEREAS, Nick exemplifies San Francisco's Finest whether in his immaculate SFPD  
24 uniform or his signature crewneck grey sweatshirt; and

25 WHEREAS, Nick retires on February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2006; now, therefore, be it


