RESOLUTION NO. 32-00

1 [Sewer Emergency]

2 APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY WORK TO  
3 REPLACE THE STRUCTURALLY INADEQUATE SEWER ON FILBERT STREET FROM  
4 VAN NESS AVENUE TO FRANKLIN STREET AND ROSE STREET FROM GOUGH  
5 STREET TO MARKET STREET.

6 WHEREAS, On September 9, 1999, PUC Sewer Operations identified an emergency sewer  
7 condition on Filbert Street from Van Ness Avenue to Franklin Street and Rose Street from Gough  
8 Street to Market Street; and

9 WHEREAS, The existing 16-inch diameter sewer located on Filbert Street from Van Ness  
10 Avenue to Franklin Street had open joints, deformed sections, and multiple cracks, and the  
11 existing 12-inch diameter sewer on Rose Street from Gough Street to Market Street had open  
12 joints resulting in sand infiltration; and

13 WHEREAS, Immediate repairs were required in order to protect the health, welfare, and  
14 property of the Citizens of San Francisco; and

15 WHEREAS, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for  
16 Contract No. CW-258E, "Filbert/Rose Streets Emergency Sewer Replacement" to replace the  
17 existing sewers with approximately 255 feet of 12-inch and 408 feet of 18-inch diameter vitrified  
18 clay pipe (VCP) sewers; and

19 WHEREAS, The Contractor, Harty Pipelines, began the emergency work on October 13,  
20 1999 and all work is specified to be completed on or before November 9, 1999 (for a total of 28  
21 calendar days); and

22 WHEREAS, Because this is an emergency contract, HRC subcontracting goals are not  
23 required; and

24 WHEREAS, The cost of the project is projected to be  $\frac{\$256,083}{\$248,734.00}$ , of which  $\frac{\$196,933}{\$189,584.00}$  is  
25 for the construction contract. Funds are available from the 1995B Sewer Bond under Job Order

1 No. 0119J (Fund 5C/CPF/95B, FAMIS Project No. CEN95BSI0040); and

2 WHEREAS, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.30 of  
3 the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an emergency;  
4 now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the  
6 emergency work to replace the structurally inadequate sewer on Filbert Street from Van Ness Avenue to  
7 Franklin Street and Rose Street from Gough Street to Market Street.


