10 WHEREAS, Teen suicide rates have increased 300% since the 1950's; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Mental Health Association of San Francisco is sponsoring sites  
12 throughout San Francisco on October 5, National Depression Screening Day, to provide  
13 screening to people who may be suffering from depression; now, therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
15 recognizes October 5, 2000 as National Depression Screening Day; and be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commends the Mental Health  
17 Association of San Francisco for their efforts to obtain treatment for those who suffer from  
18 depression.


