[ACCEPTANCE OF GIFT]

AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE RECREATION AND PARK DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT, ON BEHALF OF THAT DEPARTMENT, A GIFT OF VOLUNTEER LABOR SERVICES, INCLUDING THE COST OF EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS, VALUED IN EXCESS OF \$5000.00 FROM THE CARPENTERS LOCAL 22, CARPENTERS LOCAL 2236, GLAZIERS LOCAL 718, PLUMBERS LOCAL 38, MILLWRIGHTS LOCAL 102, PAINTERS LOCAL 4 (DISTRICT COUNCIL 8) AND THE SAN FRANCISCO BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION TRADES COUNCIL TO REPAIR THE CONSERVATORY OF FLOWERS UNDER THE COORDINATION AND DIRECTION OF THE RECREATION AND PARK DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Conservatory of Flowers opened in 1879 and is the oldest building in Golden Gate Park; and,

WHEREAS, The Conservatory of Flowers is one of San Francisco's most treasured landmarks and houses important and valuable botanical collections including rare high altitude orchids; and,

WHEREAS, The Conservatory of Flowers was damaged by storms in the past few years; and

WHEREAS, The Conservatory of Flowers currently has significant structural deficiencies which, in the absence of seismic strengthening, pose substantial safety risks; and

WHEREAS, The Conservatory of Flowers is closed to the public due to such storm damage and structural deficiencies; and,

WHEREAS, Several fundraising efforts are proceeding to fully restore the Conservatory of Flowers Building; and

WHEREAS, Until such time that restoration can occur, the plant collection housed within the Conservatory of Flowers is in jeopardy of serious damage or destruction; and

WHEREAS, The Carpenters Local 22, Carpenters Local 2236, Glaziers Local 718, Plumbers Local 38 and the San Francisco Building and Construction Trades Council have graciously offered to make the following necessary interim repairs of the building in order to protect the plant collection: (1) to repair the glazing in growing houses #1 and #2, (2) to repair the vents in the main Conservatory and growing houses #1 and #2, (3) to remove and use parts of the fiberglass on the lathhouse roof and sides as temporary roofing for the Bromeliad house, and (4) to repair and/or replace heating elements in the west wing and dome room; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of the Recreation and Park Department to accept, on behalf of that department, a gift of volunteer labor services, including the cost of equipment and materials, valued in excess of \$5000.00 from the Carpenters Local 22, Carpenters Local 2236, Glaziers Local 718, Plumbers Local 38, Millwrights Local 102, Painters Local 4 (District Council 8) and the San Francisco Building and Construction Trades Council to repair the Conservatory of Flowers under the coordination and direction of the Recreation and Park Department.
