111213	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:		
14	Section 1. Article 11 of the Park Code is hereby amended by revising Sections 11.01,		
15	11.02, 11.03, and 11.04, to read as follows:		
16	SEC. 11.01. AUTHORITY OF THE REAL ESTATE DIVISION REDEVELOPMENT		
17	AGENCY COMMISSION.		
18	Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, and consistent with Resolution No.		
19	162-18, the Director of Property, or the Director's designee, governing body of the Redevelopment		
20	Agency of the City and County of San Francisco-shall have the exclusive authority to set rules for		
21	Yerba Buena Gardens pursuant to Article 3 of this Code, to issue permits for Yerba Buena		
22	Gardens pursuant to Article 7 of this Code, and to designate persons who shall perform all		
23	other functions for Yerba Buena Gardens which would be performed by the General Manager		
24	Superintendent of Recreation, orand Superintendent of Parks for any other park under this		
25	Code.		

SEC. 11.02. CERTAIN ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES PROHIBITED.

No person shall participate in any team athletic activity in the Yerba Buena Gardens, including but not limited to volleyball, baseball, soccer, football, or lacrosse, nor <u>shall any</u> <u>person engage</u> in <u>the individual activities of roller skating, roller blading, bicycle riding, kite flying</u> or skateboarding, except when acting pursuant to a permit issued by the <u>Director of Property or</u> the Director's <u>Commission or its</u> designee.

SEC. 11.03. ANIMALS-PROHIBITED.

No person, other than members of the San Francisco Police Department when on duty, shall bring any animals, <u>other than dogs which shall be leashed at all times, including but not limited to dogs, cats and horses,</u> into the Yerba Buena Gardens except when acting pursuant to a permit issued by the <u>Director of Property or the Director's Commission or its</u> designee.

Notwithstanding the above provision, a person with a disability may enter the Yerba Buena Gardens with a guide or signal dog without a permit.

SEC. 11.04. WHEELED EQUIPMENT PROHIBITED.

No person, other than *employees or agents of the Commission or its contractors members of the San Francisco Police Department* when on duty, shall *operatebring* any wheeled conveyances, including but not limited to trucks, cars, *bicycles, electric scooters,* and skateboards, in *to* the Yerba Buena Gardens except when acting pursuant to a permit issued by the *Director of Property or the Director's Commission or its* designee. Notwithstanding the above provision, wheelchairs, strollers, and toys *or conveyances* appropriate for preschool children, such as wagons and tricycles, may be *operated brought* in *to* Yerba Buena Gardens

1	without a permit. Bicycles may be walked through the gardens or locked in designated
2	locations without a permit.
3	
4	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
5	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
6	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
7	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
8	
9	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
10	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
11	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
12	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
13	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
14	the official title of the ordinance.

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Park Code - Yerba Buena Gardens]

Ordinance amending the Park Code to allow dogs and certain athletic activities in Yerba Buena Gardens; to clarify that existing law prohibits the riding of bicycles and electric scooters in the Gardens; and to make a non-substantive correction regarding the authority of the Real Estate Division.

Existing Law

The City's Real Estate Division oversees the Yerba Buena Gardens. Animals are not allowed in the Gardens. Certain athletic activities, and the operation of wheeled equipment, are also not allowed in the Gardens.

Amendments to Current Law

The ordinance would allow people to bring dogs to Yerba Buena Gardens, if the dogs stay leashed. The ordinance would also allow roller skating, roller blading, and kite flying in the Gardens, and would clarify that bicycles and electric scooters are prohibited.

Background Information

The ordinance contains a non-substantive correction, to reflect that Yerba Buena Gardens is no longer under the jurisdiction of the former Redevelopment Agency and instead falls under the authority of the Real Estate Division (Board Resolution No. 162-18).

Subject: Ordinance Amending the Park Code To Allow Does and Certain Athletic Activities in Yerba Buena Gardens

Dear Board Members:

Attached for your consideration is an Ordinance approving and authorizing amendments to the Park Code to allow dogs and certain athletic activities in yerba Buena gardens; to clarify that existing law prohibits the riding of bicycles and electric scooters in the Gardens; and to make a non-substantive correction regarding the authority of the Real Estate Division.

In or about June 2018, the City and County of San Francisco (City) acquired from the Office of Community Investment and Infrastructure (formerly the Redevelopment Agency) and it was put under the jurisdiction of the Real Estate Division.

On or about June 14, 2019, the City entered into a Master Lease Agreement with the Yerba Buena Gardens Conservancy, a California non-profit public benefit corporation (YBGC) for the Yerba Buena Gardens through 2061. The lease requires YBGC to manage and operate portions of the City-owned urban mixed-use property (the Gardens).

During the last several years, YBGC has been managing the Gardens and noted several issues including: a) All athletic activities are prohibited; b) Dogs are prohibited; and c) Visitors are prohibited from all wheeled equipment including strollers, wagons, etc.

YBGC desires to allow certain athletic activities under permits issued by the Director of Property or the Director's designee; allow leashed dogs; and allow certain wheeled conveyances (strollers, wheelchairs, toys, wagons, etc., and allow bicycles to be walked through the Gardens. This ordinance provides for those changes.
